

A news story produced by Danika Peterson was not only the most popular video on our social media channels this month, it is the most popular video we have posted since we began our new emphasis on short form video content. The story on the new Asia Mall coming to Blaine garnered an impressive 60,777 views in May. The video was particularly popular on Facebook, with 827 reactions (including 820 likes) and 141 comments. It is also a great example of a local story that viewers cannot find anywhere else as North Metro TV was the only television outlet present at the news conference.

#### **Centerville History**

TJ Tronson delved into the history of Centerville this month with the video "A Wonderful Place to Grow Up." The video, which features interviews with five long-time Centerville residents, is the first of a series of at least four videos recounting tales of the city. Since TJ began working on the videos, one of the participants, Robert Barett, passed away. A sort of added bonus of the project was that TJ was able to provide his family with a video of Robert's full interview, sharing stories of his childhood. As one might imagine, they were delighted to have it. TJ has very much enjoyed working on the project and



intends to create similar videos for each of our member cities.

#### **NMTV Celebrates May the 4th**

North Metro TV celebrated Star Wars Day (also known as May the 4<sup>th</sup>) with a brand new video. The short features News Producer Eric Nelson as Darth Vader as the famous film villain tries to get NMTV to transfer his home movies. Produced by Eric Houston and TJ Tronson, the video served several purposes, including creating fun, highly topical content for the channel and social media, serving as an evergreen promo for our home movie transfer service, and offering a team building opportunity for staff.



#### **Music at Centennial Schools**

Kenton Kipp and the sports team took a break from the ballfield this month with a trio of videos covering Centennial Schools musical events. Kenton and his crew filmed the Centennial High School Choir Cabaret, the Centenial Middle School Spring Concert, and the Centennial High School Encore Choir Concert. All of the programs are available to watch on YouTube, offering grandparents and other distant family friends the chance to watch the students sing their hearts out. More than 1,200 people have watched the three videos. They are also the last three events of a seven event package that the school district hired us for last September.

#### LaMotte Park Rocket Launch

TJ Tronson joined Scouts of America Pack 232 at Centerville's LaMotte Park for their annual rocket launch. Boys and girls aged kindergarten through fifth grade teamed with MASA (Minnesota Amateur Spacemodeler Association) to learn about aerodynamics and STEM subjects through the fun and excitement of a model rocket. TJ had a blast (pardon the pun) and the kids loved seeing themselves on TV.



North Metro TV was proud to cover this year's Memorial Day ceremony at Veterans Memorial Park of Blaine. The solemn event featured a keynote speech from retired Brigadier General Joseph P. Kelley and the final military honors for John Rice, namesake of the Blaine VFW. The hour long program is airing on Channel 15 and is available on YouTube.

#### **Police Recruitment**

This month, Municipal Producer Trevor Scholl completed his long in the works Community Outreach video for the Blaine Police Department. Fourteen months in the making, Trevor attended multiple police sponsored events and conducted more than a dozen interviews to make this video a reality. Designed to encourage volunteerism amongst new BPD recruits, the video highlights such initiatives as Polar Plunge, the Citizens Academy, the Explorers Program, and the Summer Safety Camp. Trevor provided the department with a version of the video to use internally and edited a special, public facing version for air on channel 15.

#### **City Productions**

In addition to the Police Recruitment video, Trevor Scholl also highlighted Griswold Homecare, a local company that, amongst other things, helps the elderly with visits from

therapy dogs. He also filmed the recent Walk for Animals, the SBM Fire Senior Safety Fair, and created promos for Tower Days and the Pavilions at Golden Lake Park.

Trevor touches base with contacts on a regular basis and also encourages cities to contact him with ideas for new videos.
